

Clearwater Secondary School Schedule of School Fees 2009-2010

Optional Fees for Enhancement Activities/Goods and Services at CSS:

1. Information Technology 10-12 (\$5): For paper costs associated with students printing projects/assignments in class.
2. Video Production 11-12 (\$10): For provision of diskettes for student use and possession of video production assignments and paper costs associated with students printing projects/assignments in class.
3. Art 10-12 (\$20): For provision of paper and supplies for completion and student possession of basic projects.
4. Drawing and Painting 10-12 (\$20): For provision of paper and supplies for completion and student possession of basic projects.
5. Ceramics 10-12 (\$35): For provision of clay and student possession of completed, fired basic projects.
6. Woodwork/Creative Woodwork 10 (\$25): For provision and possession of materials and completed basic course projects.
7. Carpentry and Joinery 11-12 (\$35): For provision and possession of materials and completed basic course projects.
8. Metalwork 9/10 (\$35): For provision and possession of materials and completed basic course projects.
9. Auto Mechanics 11/12 (\$10): For provision of shop rags, top-up fluids (eg. Brake fluid, antifreeze, etc.), and minor parts (eg. Nuts, bolts, etc.) for students working on personal vehicles.
10. Power Mechanics 9/10 (\$5): For provision of shop rags, top-up fluids (eg. gas, antifreeze, etc.), and minor parts (eg. Nuts, bolts, etc.) for students working on personal small engines.
11. Drafting 10-12 (\$5): For paper costs associated with students printing projects/assignments in class.
12. Foods 10 (\$35): For food costs associated with consumption of basic projects completed in class.
13. Foods 9/10 (\$45): For food costs associated with consumption of basic projects completed in class.
14. Physical Education 11-12 (up to \$45): For facility rental costs and transportation to optional community activities. Actual amount (but no more than \$45) dependent upon number of optional field trips scheduled for classes in September 2009.
15. Metalwork 9 (\$20): For provision and possession of materials and completed basic course projects.
16. Woodwork 9 (\$15): For provision and possession of materials and completed basic course projects.
17. Art 9 (\$10): For provision of paper and supplies for completion and student possession of basic projects.
