Award Criteria and Description:

- The prime emphasis is to recognize students who have demonstrated outstanding service and commitment to their school and/or community through significant leadership and selfless dedication.
- It seeks to identify those service-oriented students who show initiative in bringing an idea to fruition and whose leadership makes a significant contribution to their school or community.
- The award will be decided with consideration being given as follows:
 - **School/Community Service:** Leadership is the prime criterion. Applicants must have made a significant contribution through leadership to their school and/or community.
 - **Academic Achievement:** Minimum GPA of 2.5 as of April in their graduating year. Courses chosen should support their chosen post secondary field.
- **The final decision will be based on the significance of the leadership contribution made by the applicant. In the event of a tie, then the degree of involvement in school and community activities shall be considered.**

Amount and Distribution:

- Amount is variable each year. The award is disbursed by the Kamloops Foundation.

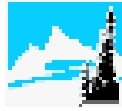

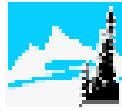

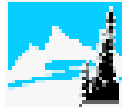

Scholarship & Bursary Awards Description and Criteria - KTSAA

The objective of the scholarship and bursary funds is to provide one or more scholarships and/or bursaries to one or more graduating students of School District #73 (Kamloops/Thompson) who intend to pursue further post secondary education. The School District #73 Scholarship Committee will make the selections.

- 1. TRU ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES:** **Established April, 1988**
 - These awards have been established by the former Kamloops District Student Awards Association. These awards can only be used at Thompson Rivers University.
 - There is **ONE** scholarship named the **Tony Embleton Scholarship** valued at \$800.00. There are **TWO** Scholarships of up to \$550.00 each. Financial need is not a factor for the scholarships.
 - There are **THREE** bursaries, valued at \$550.00 each, one of which is named the **Ed Tait Bursary**.
 - **Financial need is factor for the bursaries.**

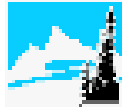
- 2. DIRECTORS' SCHOLARSHIP (K.T.S.A.A.):** **Established March, 1995**
 - The Directors of the former Kamloops District Student Awards Association established this scholarship. It is to be awarded to a top scholar in School District #73 (Kamloops/Thompson). The funds may be used at any post secondary institution.
 - Financial need is **not** a factor.
 - There is **ONE** award valued at \$1500.00. **Interview Required**

- 3. THE C. J. BESSETTE MEMORIAL AWARD:** **Established February, 1979**
 - Beverley A. Marriott established this fund in memory of her father, Cleophas J. Bessette, a longtime, well-known lumberman who resided in the Kamloops and Lumby districts. The funds may be used at any post secondary institution.
 - There will be an award of \$1000.00 a female and an award of \$1000.00 to a male graduate of School District #73 (Kamloops/ Thompson). **Interview Required**

- 4. SD#73 SCHOLARSHIPS (K.T.S.A.A.):** **Established March, 1995**
 - The Directors of the former Kamloops Thompson Student Awards Association established these scholarships.
 - The SD#73 Scholarships will be awarded to two scholarship candidates where financial need is not a factor. **Students awarded a SD#73 scholarship or award will not be awarded a bursary as well.** The funds may be used at any post secondary institution.
 - Financial need is **not** a factor.
 - There are **TWO** scholarships valued at \$750.00 each. **Interview Required.**

- 5. THE ROTHERY MEMORIAL AWARDS:** **Established November, 1983**
 - The funds provided by the Estate of J. V. Rothery have been used by the former Kamloops District Student Awards Association to establish these awards. The funds may be used at any post secondary institution.
 - There are four awards valued at \$750.00 each.
 - **Financial need is a factor.**

- 6. THE CLARENCE MCRAE BRODIE AWARD:** **Established April, 1975**
 - This award is provided from a trust fund set up in the will of Mr. Brodie. The funds may be used at any post secondary institution.
 - The exact sum may vary from time to time but will amount to approximately \$400.00 in a given year.
 - **Financial need is a factor.**

The objective of the scholarship and bursary funds is to provide one or more scholarships and/or bursaries to one or more graduating students of School District #73 (Kamloops/Thompson) who intend to pursue further post secondary education. The School District #73 Scholarship Committee will make the selections.

1. EVENING AUXILIARY TO ROYAL INLAND HOSPITAL BURSARY: 2 @ \$500

- Must be graduating from a public school with the city of Kamloops boundaries.
- Applicant should be a “solid B student” and have good effort marks in grades 11 & 12.
- Active participation in the school and community.
- Intention to pursue post secondary studies in a health related field.
- Preference given to applicants who have not received other awards.
- **Demonstration of financial need.**

2. GERRY KENNEY MEMORIAL BURSARY: 1 @ \$300

KAMLOOPS COMMUNITY MUSIC SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP: 1 @ \$300

- Applicants must show evidence of:
 - a. Festivals entered/awards won
 - b. Service to community music
 - c. School music involvement
 - d. Service to other school and community activities
- Letter of reference from the music teacher.
- Must attend TRU with plans to pursue a post secondary Music Program or an Education Program with a Music Major.
- If you are attending an institution other than TRU your application will be considered by the committee and 50% of the award may be awarded.

3. Gordon R. Gore Scholarship/Bursary Award: 1 @ \$500

- Applicants will show scholastic standing
- **Applicants must be graduating from Westsyde Secondary School.**
- Demonstrate a genuine interest in hands-on science or technology. For example: significant project work, involvement in a science club or participation in science contests.
- Demonstrate service within the science or technology fields. For example: tutoring, science lab assistant, candy strippers, BLSC, BC Wildlife Park etc.
- Selection will be adjudicated by the Big Little Science Centre Scholarship/Bursary Committee.
- **Demonstration of financial need.**

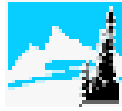
4. HENRY GRUBE MEMORIAL BURSARY: 1 @ \$1,000

- For students in School District #73 who intend to enter primary teacher training.
- Applicants must demonstrate a concern for and interest in the environment and involvement with young children by including a personal letter to support this.
- A minimum “B” average is required.
- Award may be given to a student intending to pursue elementary education if there is no suitable applicant in primary education.
- **Demonstration of financial need.**

5. KAMLOOPS BAR ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP: 2 @ \$500

HARRIS & CO. LAW OFFICES SCHOLARSHIP: 1 @ \$200

- Applicant must have demonstrated strength in Law 12.
- Applicant must include a letter from their Law 12 teacher.
- **Must demonstrate clarity of future goals including a career in law or a related field.**

6. KAMLOOPS DAILY NEWS BURSARY: 1 @ \$500

- Applicant must include route number in application.
- Must have been a carrier for the Kamloops Daily News for more than one year.
- **Demonstration of financial need.**

7. KAMLOOPS REGIONAL CORRECTIONS CENTRE COMMUNITY AWARD: 1 @ \$500

- Applicant must be a graduate from a SD#73 school.
- Must have a minimum B-average or better in Grade 11 & 12 courses.
- Applicant must demonstrate good character and proven leadership and service to the community and/or school.
- Preference will be given to a child of a KRCC employee, but all graduating students may apply.
- Must be entering a post secondary education program for the fall.

8. KAMLOOPS THOMPSON TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP: 1 @ \$1000

- Applicant must be a graduate from a SD#73 school.
- Applicant must be the son or daughter of a KTTA member and indicate the member's name on the application.
- Academic achievement, school and community involvement are considered.

9. KAMLOOPS THOMPSON TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION BURSARY: 1 @ \$1000

- Applicant must be a graduate from a SD#73 school.
- Applicant must be the son or daughter of a KTTA member and indicate the member's name on the application.
- **Demonstration of financial need is the primary factor for this award.**
- Reasonable academic success is also considered.

10. LION'S CLUB BURSARY: 2 @ \$750

- First preference is given to a physically or mentally challenged student.
- Second preference is given to a student who plans to pursue a career in the Human Service Work field.
- Academic achievement of student should allow him/her to enter a post secondary course of study.
- **Demonstration of financial need.**

11. TOLKO BURSARY: 2 @ \$850

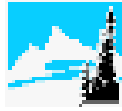
- Applicant must be the child of an active Tolko, **Heffley Creek Division** employee.
- Factors to be considered are demonstration of financial need, academic ability, & community involvement.

12. VIC MOWBRAY ENDOWMENT FUND: 1 @ \$500

- Applicant must be registered in a performing arts or Journalism program, preferably at TRU.
- Must have a concentration of performing arts courses at the Grade 11/12.
- Must have a resume of activities in the performing arts.
- Must submit an essay on how the performing arts defines or enhances a nation's sense of identity through culture.
